What is HCAP?

Honolulu Community Action Program, Inc. is a private, non-profit 501(c)(3) agency that has been serving Oahu's low-income residents since 1965.

What does HCAP do?

HCAP offers a range of programs and services to assist individuals and families to gain self-sufficiency. Annually, HCAP impacts over 20,000 people on Oahu.

What is HCAP's mission?

HCAP serves the local community through its mission of **POI: Providing Opportunities and Inspiration** to enable low-income individuals or families to achieve self-reliance.

What programs does HCAP offer?

HCAP offers programs and services in six major areas: Early Childhood; Employment; Education; Economic Development; Emergency & Transitional Programs; and Community Development & Advocacy.

Who is eligible for HCAP's programs?

Service Area

The Harry & Jeanette Weinberg Center for Community Action, Leeward District Service Center is located in Waiʻanae. Its geographical service boundaries are from Kapolei to Makaha. The newly renovated center is under the auspices of the Honolulu Community Action Program, Inc., and is part of a five District Service Center network throughout the island of Oʻahu.



Additional Programs

The **Kupuna Independent Life Series** focuses on the health and social well-being of seniors. **Stepping Stones: The Homeless Health Project**, is a series of weekly workshops meant to teach unsheltered homeless individuals pertinent life skills and health related issues. In 2014, the **HCAP Free Health Center** will open. This free clinic will offer non-urgent medical care for community members in Waiʻanae who are uninsured or under-insured, and might be seeking alternatives to seeing a doctor or visiting an emergency room.

The Harry & Jeanette Weinberg Center for Community Action, Leeward District Service Center offers programs and services that meet the specific needs of various minority populations in the Waiʻanae area. All programs have a teaching component to engage active participants and enable them to gain the skills needed to live successful lives.
