What is Kumuhonua?

Kumuhonua is a transitional living center located at Kalaeloa, Barbers Point.

Kumuhonua is for single adults and couples (18 and over) who are homeless or at-risk for homelessness.

Our Services

Kumuhonua provides housing, case management services and rapid rehousing support to residents. Program fees are charged at 30% of gross income. Kumuhonua staff also offer numerous on-site workshops. Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Financial management
- Health and nutrition
- Substance abuse
- Family relationships
- Job readiness training and placement
- Fair housing
